Dr. Sinkford also became the first woman dean of a dental school in the U.S. in 1975 and served in that capacity for 16 years. She has received Alumni Achievement Awards from Northwestern University and Howard University and numerous other citations for exceptional professional achievement including being selected as the first woman to receive the Outstanding Leader in Dentistry honor by the International College of Dentists. She has been a member of the Institute of Medicine, National Academy of Sciences since 1975.
