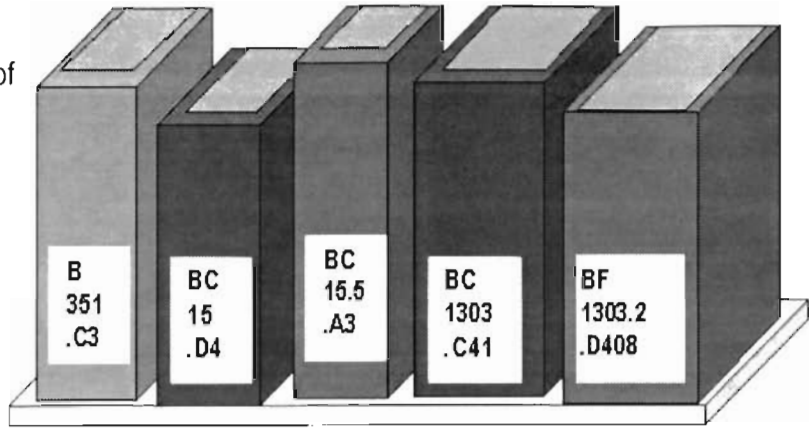


Where's My Book? Try these tips to find it:

1. Are you in the right area? VCU Libraries uses Library of Congress call numbers to arrange books. Check that the location where you looked is correct. Call numbers are arranged this way:



2. Could the item be checked out? Click on "Is this item available" in the item's record in the catalog. If there is a date in the "Due Date" field, the item is checked out.

3. Check nearby. Look on tables or near photocopiers; someone else may have been using the item.

4. Check the third floor reshelving area. Carts there are arranged by call number; the shelves are more loosely arranged by the beginning letter of the call number.
