

Importing Citations from ProQuest Databases into RefWorks

This guide applies to the following databases:

In ProQuest:

- Mark records to import by checking the boxes next to the citations.
- Click **Export**.
- Click **Export Directly to RefWorks**.
- If you have not yet logged into RefWorks, you will be prompted for your username and password.
- Your citations will appear in the **Last Imported** folder.

OR

- Mark records to import by checking the boxes next to the citations.
- Click **[#] Marked Items**.
- Click **Export Citations**.
- If you have not yet logged into RefWorks, you will be prompted for your username and password.
- Your citations will appear in the **Last Imported** folder.

NOTE: You may mark records within any of the **Document** views, e.g., Abstract, Full Text, PDF, but you will see the **Export** and **[#] Marked Items** links only in the **Results** view.
