






Anatomy.TV Tip Sheet

Anatomy.TV is an interactive 3D model of human anatomy online. Models can be rotated and layers can be peeled away to view medically accurate representations of anatomical structures. Clicking on different sections of an image will pull up labels and descriptive text along with links to videos and radiological images.

Here are a few tips to help you get the most out of using Anatomy.TV:

- Logoff – only 5 users from VCU can be logged in at one time. Please click Logoff when done so someone else can gain access.
- Browser – for optimal results, use Internet Explorer.
- Pop-ups – your browser must be configured to allow pop-up windows. Consult the help section of your browser if you need to change this setting.
- Movies/animations – view with either Windows Media or Quicktime player.
- Alternate spellings – because this product was developed by a U.K. company, you may need to search keywords with British and American spellings. For example: goiter/goitre or tumor/tumour

Print	Click image or highlight text. Right click and select Print Picture or Print (for text)	Click on printer icon at top. Then, choose what to print.	Images: click printer icon below image. Text: click printer icon at bottom of text frame.
Search	From Contents tab, type term and hit Search Now	Search icon at bottom right corner of page. Can search by categories (optional) and/or type a search term in the search box, then click search.	Click on the search icon at the top left of the screen to search the contents of this title.
Change settings	Not applicable	Click  icon to left of question mark. 3 settings options appear and only apply to the current session.	Click  icon to left of question mark if you wish to change settings for current session.
Go to index	Not applicable	Click on Search icon at bottom right, then click on Index for alphabetical list.	Click Index icon at top left for alphabetical list.
Save an image (jpeg format)	Right click on image and select save.	Click on Save icon at top; then click “save file.”	Click on Save icon at the bottom middle of the page; then, click “save file.”
Save a movie	Launch the movie. Right click on the link above the movie that says “If the movie does not start playing, please click here.” Select Save Target As.	(for 3D Head) Click on “Movies” at top left, then click on “Movie List” at bottom right. After launching the movie, right click on link at top of movie.	Click on icon at lower left to save movie.
Create a web link	Not applicable	Change settings to enable Weblinks. Then, click “Copy Weblink” and paste.	Click on Star at top left. To save a temporary bookmark (current session only) click Star on left of dialog box. To create a web link, click  , highlight and copy URL, then paste.
