Reports and Discussion

VCU Libraries Overview and Update

Dean Irene Herold greeted VLAC members and provided a brief overview of <u>VCU Libraries'</u> mission statement and the <u>role of VLAC</u>. She also discussed VCU Libraries' Strategic Framework and our priorities and timeline for the next 18 months. For the full presentation, please see the <u>slide</u> deck.

Springer Nature Update

During her presentation, Tammy Sugarman (Associate Dean for Collections, Discovery, & Budget) provided an update on the recent <u>Springer Nature</u> negotiations. VIVA has negotiated a two-year agreement beginning January 1, 2024 and ending December 31, 2025 so VCU will retain access to Springer journals until December 31, 2025. As a result of this new agreement, VCUL saved approximately \$100,000. <u>See slide deck here</u>.

Jimmy Ghaphery (Associate Dean for Scholarly Communications & Publishing) discussed <u>VIVA</u> and how it has contributed to the success of VCU Libraries and other Virginia academic libraries. VIVA is the consortium of 71 academic libraries within the Commonwealth of Virginia.



For more than 25 years, VIVA has created significant cost savings through cooperative purchasing, resource sharing, and open and affordable course content initiatives.
